












Homework

Homework is an important part of learning at Abbs Cross. All pupils are expected to complete the homework that is set, and this should be recorded in their planner. Parents are asked to check their child's planner on a weekly basis, and sign it each weekend; tutors will sign it the following week. When signing your child's planner, this is a good opportunity to check that the work has been completed and to have a discussion with your son or daughter about their home learning.

Pupils will not be set homework which is due in the following day.

Each pupil is issued with a homework timetable which should be in their planner. There is an exemplar below. A substantial piece of homework may be set over a number of weeks. Subjects such as DT, Dance and PE will also set homework as appropriate.

At Key Stage Four, the homework demands increase, and pupils should expect to be set at least one hour of homework per subject per week. As at Key Stage Three, homework should not be set which is due in the following day. Substantive pieces of homework may be set over a number of weeks. Pupils who are studying subjects such as Art or those where there is an NEA can expect assignments to be set over a longer period of time, with interim deadlines.
